

# **Project Summary: Timor Leste Community Education Project**

### **Objectives:**

Yellow Dove Australia embarked on a successful 10-day mission to Timor Leste, delivering First Aid & CPR training across Dili, Tibar, Gleno, and Arturo Island. This cultural immersion and community education initiative, made possible through funding from the Wanless Family Fund via the Australian Communities Foundation, this funding of \$15,000 including Yellow Dove Australia's \$2,000 contributed to:

- Provided essential lifesaving First Aid & CPR skills to local communities.
- Strengthen community independence and emergency response capabilities.
- Equip local organisations with the necessary tools for ongoing safety and health practices.

- Foster cultural exchange and build mutual understanding through immersive engagement with the Timorese community.

- Travel Arrangements
- 6x Remote First Aid Kits
- Training Materials (Print Out)
- CPR Pocket Masks



### Outcomes:

- Training Reach: 175 Timorese individuals were trained, with 99% experiencing First Aid and CPR training for the first time.

- Increased Confidence: Participants reported improved knowledge, confidence, and crowd management skills in responding to emergency situations.

- Equipment Distribution: Each participating organization received a remote first aid kit, and every individual was gifted an emergency pocket mask to further empower the communities with tools for emergency response.

- Positive Community Impact: The project significantly raised awareness about the importance of emergency care, resulting in increased enthusiasm for further community education efforts.

- Training Locations: Dili, Tibar, Gleno, Arturo Island.

- Equipment Distributed: 1:6 remote first aid kit per organisation, 1:6 inflatable CPR manikin per organisation, 175 emergency CPR pocket masks for individual participants.

- First Aid & CPR training programs to build on the foundational skills already provided, by continuing this project to educate more people, over a longer timeframe.

- Emergency response team development, focusing on local leadership in safety management.

- Health education sessions integrated with future First Aid training, focusing on hygiene practices and illness prevention.

- Job creation and sustainability by providing 'Train the Trainer'; training Timorese people to become certified trainers in First Aid & CPR, empowering them to train others in their communities.





To further expand our First Aid and CPR Community Education project, we are actively seeking additional funding and support to sustain these efforts, acquire more equipment, and extend the project to reach even more communities across Timor Leste.

Over the course of 10 days, 175 participants from Dili, Tibar, Gleno, and Arturo Island were trained, with 99% experiencing First Aid and CPR training for the first time. This life-saving knowledge not only enhanced the participants' confidence and competence in emergency response but also empowered them to take charge of their community's safety and wellbeing.

Through the generous contributions from our supporters, each participating organization received a remote first aid kit, and every individual was equipped with an emergency pocket mask to ensure they were prepared to act in critical situations.
