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




Ryan Chapman - Founder, Director & Member Assistance - Education Pillar

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Highlights of the Year

Successful Fundraiser by Kocreate - Supplying Washing Machines to Wiluna Remote Community.

We are incredibly proud to share the success of our collaborative effort with Kocreate to provide washing machines to families in the Wiluna Remote Community. Kocreate's event night in April 2024

raised \$1800, which was directed toward purchasing two high-quality washing machines for families in need. Despite logistical and transport challenges, the machines were successfully delivered on July 19th, 2024. We would like to extend heartfelt gratitude to Bevan and Hera from the Shire of Wiluna for their patience in holding the goods during the wait for delivery, as well as Anne-Marie from the Shire for her incredible effort in transporting the machines from Kalgoorlie, a 10-hour return trip. The community support was pivotal, and Mr. Wayne from the Wiluna Remote Community School also played a crucial role in assisting with the final delivery. This initiative exemplifies our commitment to improving the quality of life for remote communities and providing essential resources where they are needed most.



2. June Connect - Therapeutic Art for People Living with Impairments.

The June Connect initiative, held in early June, was an inspiring and impactful event designed to foster personal development, social connections, and community engagement. Led by Ryan Chapman on behalf of Yellow Dove Australia, June Connect offered a series of therapeutic art



sessions and sensory activities aimed at individuals living with impairments. These sessions provided not only an artistic outlet for self-expression but also a means of fostering emotional connection among participants. The initiative encouraged creativity and personal growth, with caregivers and family members joining in, ensuring an inclusive environment for everyone involved. The overwhelmingly positive response from the community validated the importance of creating accessible spaces for engagement, connection, and healing. The program proved to be a significant step in fostering inclusion and creating opportunities for individuals to form new friendships, making a meaningful difference in the lives of those involved.





3. Successful First Birthday and Launch of Yellow Dove Australia.

In August, Yellow Dove Australia celebrated its first year of operations with an exciting launch event, reflecting on a year of growth, impact, and progress. This milestone was not only a celebration of our achievements but also a reaffirmation of our mission to empower and uplift marginalised communities. The event raised an impressive \$2,830, which will help support the expansion of our ongoing initiatives in education, health, and community development. This achievement highlights the trust and support of our growing network of donors, partners, and community members who are instrumental in helping us create positive change. As we reflect on this significant milestone, we are more committed than ever to continuing our work in fostering healthier, more connected, and empowered communities.

4. Sponsorship of Sunshine Coast Grammar Lifesaving Club.

Yellow Dove Australia's sponsorship of the Sunshine Coast Grammar Lifesaving Club underscores our commitment to supporting local organisations that promote safety, health, and well-being. Our contribution of \$2,000 towards the team's memberships for the 2024 World Lifesaving Championships enabled the team to participate in this prestigious event. Their success, including Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals, highlighted their exceptional skill and dedication. One of the most memorable moments was their historic win in a Lifesaving Event, marking a significant achievement for the club and the broader lifesaving community. This sponsorship aligns with Yellow Dove Australia's focus on fostering healthy communities, supporting drowning prevention education, and providing young athletes with opportunities to develop their talents on the world stage. We are proud to have played a part in their success and look forward to continued partnership in the future.

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5. Community Development Through First Aid and CPR in Timor Leste.

A key highlight of the year was Yellow Dove Australia's successful mission to Timor Leste, where we delivered First Aid and CPR training to individuals across Dili, Tibar, Gleno, and Arturo Island. This initiative was made possible thanks to funding from the Wanless Family Fund via the Australian Communities Foundation, along with Yellow Dove Australia's own contribution of \$2,000. Over the

course of the 10-day mission, 175 Timorese individuals received First Aid and CPR training, with 99% of participants learning these vital life-saving skills for the first time. The training program not only provided participants with essential knowledge and skills to respond to emergencies but also helped boost their confidence in managing critical situations. This initiative is a prime example of how Yellow Dove Australia's education programs are making a real difference in communities by enhancing safety and building resilience. We are proud to have empowered the Timorese people with the skills needed to save lives and contribute to their community's overall well-being.







6. Happiness CO Foundation – Grant Recipient, \$5,000

Yellow Dove Australia is thrilled to announce that we have been awarded a \$5,000 grant from the Happiness Co Foundation to deliver our Cultural Connection program. This initiative aims to empower youth and adults of Aboriginal heritage by fostering pride in their culture through therapeutic art and tactile activities. The program will create opportunities for participants to connect with their heritage, build a sense of belonging, and strengthen community ties. We are incredibly grateful to the Happiness Co Foundation for supporting our mission to uplift and celebrate cultural identity. To be delivered in 2025.

7. Variety Foundation – Grant Recipient, \$570

We are thrilled to announce that Yellow Dove Australia has been awarded a \$570 grant from the Variety Foundation to support our Brush and Wash Project. This wellness initiative focuses on promoting strong dental hygiene among Aboriginal students in remote schools, fostering lifelong habits for healthy smiles and overall well-being. The funding will enable us to provide essential dental hygiene resources and engaging educational sessions, empowering students to take charge of their oral health. We are grateful to the Variety Foundation for their support in making this impactful project a reality. To be delivered in 2025.

8. The Scanlon Foundation Annual Community Grants Program – Community Swim Project

We are thrilled to announce that Yellow Dove Australia has been awarded funding through The Scanlon Foundation Annual Community Grants Program. This incredible opportunity will support our Community Swim Project, empowering young people from migrant and refugee backgrounds with essential water safety skills and pathways to employment.

Through this initiative, participants aged 15-25 will learn water safety across various aquatic environments, gain qualifications as swim teachers, and receive support to secure employment in the field. This project embodies our commitment to fostering community inclusion, education, and opportunity. We are deeply grateful to the Scanlon Foundation for believing in our vision and enabling us to make a lasting impact. To be delivered in 2025.

Looking Ahead

As Yellow Dove Australia continues its mission to empower and uplift communities through education, health, and well-being initiatives, we are excited to announce the following projects, which will further our goal of creating positive, sustainable change.

First 500 Project - Train the Trainer in Timor Leste

Our "First 500 Project" aims to address the critical need for trained first responders in remote and isolated areas of Timor Leste. This initiative will train and employ local staff to deliver First Aid and CPR training to their own communities, ensuring that vital skills are passed on and accessible to those who need it most. By empowering local trainers, we are building sustainable community health infrastructure and fostering a culture of care.

Project Costs: \$40,000 (12 months)

Active Communities Project

The "Active Communities Project" will engage local Timorese people in afternoon sports programs designed to improve both physical health and mental well-being. This initiative will also offer free health checks to close the disparities in healthcare access. By encouraging active participation, we aim to promote lifelong health habits, community unity, and education on the importance of maintaining healthy minds and bodies.

DOVE AUSTRALIA Project Costs: \$30,000 (12 months)

Lifesavers and Leaders CONNECTING COMMUNITIES TO AUSTRALIA

This project focuses on developing the next generation of leaders through a two-day workshop aimed at high school students. Participants will receive emergency response training, CPR, and First Aid certifications, along with one business competency to support their employability. The "Lifesavers and Leaders" program empowers young people with critical life skills, fosters leadership potential, and instils confidence in their ability to make a difference in their communities.

Project Costs: \$37,000 (10 weeks)





Cultural Connection

Yellow Dove Australia's "Cultural Connection" program delivers therapeutic art practices to First Nations youth, fostering a deep connection to their heritage and strengthening bonds between generations. By providing a platform for Elders and youth to share culture and wisdom, this program promotes emotional well-being, cultural pride, and unity within communities.

Project Costs: \$12,000 (6 months) - FUNDED.

Community Swim

Our "Community Swim" project is designed to support migrant and refugee communities by offering swimming lessons, teaching qualifications, and employment opportunities within local pools. This initiative provides individuals with valuable skills, helps bridge gaps in community integration, and creates sustainable employment pathways within aquatic facilities. The project aims to create a more inclusive community by building confidence, skills, and job prospects.

Project Costs: \$27,000 (10 - 15 weeks) – FUNDED.

Annual Fundraising Gala, June 2025

In addition to these impactful projects, we are looking forward to hosting our Annual Fundraising Gala. This event will bring together our supporters, partners, and community members to celebrate the progress we've made and raise vital funds to continue our work. The Gala will feature guest speakers, entertainment, and opportunities for individuals and organisations to contribute to Yellow Dove Australia's initiatives. Funds raised will directly support the sustainability and expansion of our programs, ensuring that we continue to make a lasting impact in the communities we serve.

As we move forward, we remain committed to creating positive, long-lasting change. These projects reflect our continued dedication to empowering communities and fostering sustainable development. We are deeply grateful for the ongoing support of our partners, volunteers, and donors, and we look forward to the impact we can achieve together in the year ahead.





Possible Forecasts

The Cool Room: A Social Space for Mental Well-Being

"The Cool Room" is a social and therapeutic space designed to promote mental well-being through safe, structured engagement for individuals with varying needs, particularly in underserved communities. In addition to the sensory and creative art activities we currently offer, The Cool Room will evolve into a hub for peer support, mindfulness sessions, and group activities that foster connection, healing, and community bonding. By providing a safe environment for individuals to share their experiences, manage stress, and improve their mental health, The Cool Room will be integral in supporting the emotional and psychological needs of our most vulnerable groups.

We aim to expand The Cool Room's reach by increasing accessibility through extended operating hours and adding resources that enhance the program's effectiveness. This initiative aligns with Yellow Dove Australia's vision of holistic support, encompassing education, health, and wellness. We foresee The Cool Room becoming a central pillar in our community-driven approach to mental health, offering not only relief and support but also a sense of belonging and hope. Project Costs: \$150,000 (24+ months)

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Sustainability and Future Goals

As Yellow Dove Australia continues to grow, we are focusing on the sustainability of our projects and programs, with a strong emphasis on education as a cornerstone of our initiatives. Our efforts will also focus on diversifying our funding sources, with a commitment to grant writing, community fundraising, and corporate sponsorships. This will ensure that our educational programs are not only accessible but also scalable, reaching even more communities in need.
